

Terms and Conditions for the Buckley's Entertainment Centre "Weber Baby Q This Christmas" Promotion

The promotion, promotional period and promoter

1. The Buckley's Entertainment Centre "Weber Baby Q This Christmas" Promotion (the **Promotion**) comprises 10 prizes draw in venue, as described below in these terms and conditions.
2. The promotional period for the Promotion commences at 8:00am on Wednesday 6th December 2023 and ends at 7.00pm on Friday 22nd December 2023 (**Promotional Period**).
3. The Promoter for the Promotion is Geelong Combined Leagues Club trading as Buckley's Entertainment Centre, ABN 27695857079, 54 Fellmongers Road, Breakwater Victoria 3219 (together, the **Promoter**).

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

4. Entry into this Promotion is open to financial members of the Buckley's Rewards Loyalty Program (**Program**) as set out in these Terms and Conditions.
5. In order to be eligible to participate in the Promotion, a person must be aged 18 years or over, must NOT have been excluded or banned (whether self-excluded or otherwise) from Venue (defined below) (**Entrant**).
6. Directors, management and employees of the Promoter are not eligible to participate in the Promotion.

ENTRY

7. An Entrant will receive an entry into the Competition when their Buckley's Loyalty membership card is validly swiped during the Promotional Period, either:
 - (a) at a Venue kiosk; or
 - (b) at a Venue point-of-sale in connection with any food and beverage purchase made by the Entrant which earns Program loyalty points (**Qualifying Transaction**). Any in-Venue transaction connected with playing a gaming machine or gambling does not constitute a Qualifying Transaction or a valid entry.
8. Subject to these Terms and Conditions, there is an entry limit for this Prize Competition as follows:
 - (a) Limit of up to 6 entries per person per day
 - (b) 1 entry per member per day by swiping member's card at the kiosk daily.
 - (c) Up to 5 entries per person per day from food & beverage purchases.

PRIZES

9. Buckley's Entertainment Centre will award a prize to Entrants who have submitted Entries throughout the Promotional Period, in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
10. Each member is only eligible to win 1 prize each over the promotional period.
11. If an Entrant's name is drawn who has already won a prize during this promotional period then 1 redraw will occur.
12. 2 x prizes will be drawn at 7pm each night between 18th – 22nd December 2023.
13. Prize is a Weber Legacy Black Baby Q (Q1000) LP BBQ valued at \$369.00.

FINALIST DRAWS FOR MAJOR PRIZE DRAW EVENT

14. Each night throughout the Promotion, 2 (two) tickets will be selected via random from the entry barrel and then announced in the venue. Announcements will take place each night from 18th December 2023-22nd December 2023 at 7.00pm.
15. Winners will be notified by way of phone and/or email within two (2) business days of end of the promotional period (**Notification**). Buckley's Entertainment Centre will

take all reasonable steps to notify the Winners in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.

16. Winners names will also be written up in venue, name only, so that all patrons are aware of Winners.
17. The Winners' name and photograph may also be published on the Buckley's Website and social media, all photographs and images from the event are the property of Buckley's Entertainment Centre and can be used for promotions and marketing.

GENERAL

18. Any entry in the Promotion which the Promoter determines in its reasonable opinion to be fraudulent will be deemed invalid.
19. If the Promoter reasonably suspects that the Winner or redraw winner is not eligible, has breached these Terms and Conditions or has acted improperly to increase their chances of winning, the Promoter reserves the right to refuse to award that Prize.
20. All prizes eligible to be won in this Promotion (hereafter, **Prizes**) must be taken as offered and cannot be varied. All Prizes are not transferable and all non-cash Prizes are not redeemable for cash. The Promoter is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged Prizes. Subject to the consumer guarantees set out in Division 1 of Part 3-2 of the Australian Consumer Law (as defined in the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth) (**Consumer Guarantees**), the Promoter does not warrant the merchantability, suitability and/or fitness for purpose of any goods and/or services awarded as a Prize (if any).
21. Information on how to enter, and the Prizes themselves, form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in the Promotion by an Entrant (including acceptance of a Prize by an Entrant) confirms their acceptance of the Terms and Conditions governing the Promotion.
22. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to:
 - a. verify the validity of entries and Entrants (including an Entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and to disqualify any Entrant whose entry is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or who tampers with any entry process; or
 - b. refuse to award a Prize if the Promoter reasonably suspects that a Prize winner is not eligible, has breached these Terms and Conditions or has acted improperly to increase their chances of winning any prize in this Promotion.
23. Identification considered suitable for any verification is at the discretion of the Promoter. A Prize winner may be required to complete a statutory declaration to confirm their eligibility to accept a Prize. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
24. Except as specified otherwise in these Terms and Conditions, if for any reason a winner does not redeem the Prize or an element of the Prize at the time stipulated by the Promoter, then the prize or that element of the prize will be forfeited.
25. Decisions of the management of the Promoter are final. No correspondence will be entered into. To the extent that a situation or issue arises for which these Terms and Conditions make no provision or in relation to which the relevant Terms and Conditions are unclear, the Promoter reserves the right to make a decision regarding such situation or issue in its sole and absolute discretion and such decision will be final and binding
